Hearing loss is one of the most common undetected and untreated health problems. According to a health survey 15% of adults aged 45 – 65 years and 27% of adults aged 65 – 74 years have a significant hearing loss. BUT hearing loss too often goes unnoticed and the person with the problem is sadly the last one to realise it. As a result many people put off getting help and suffer unnecessarily with untreated hearing loss for many years.

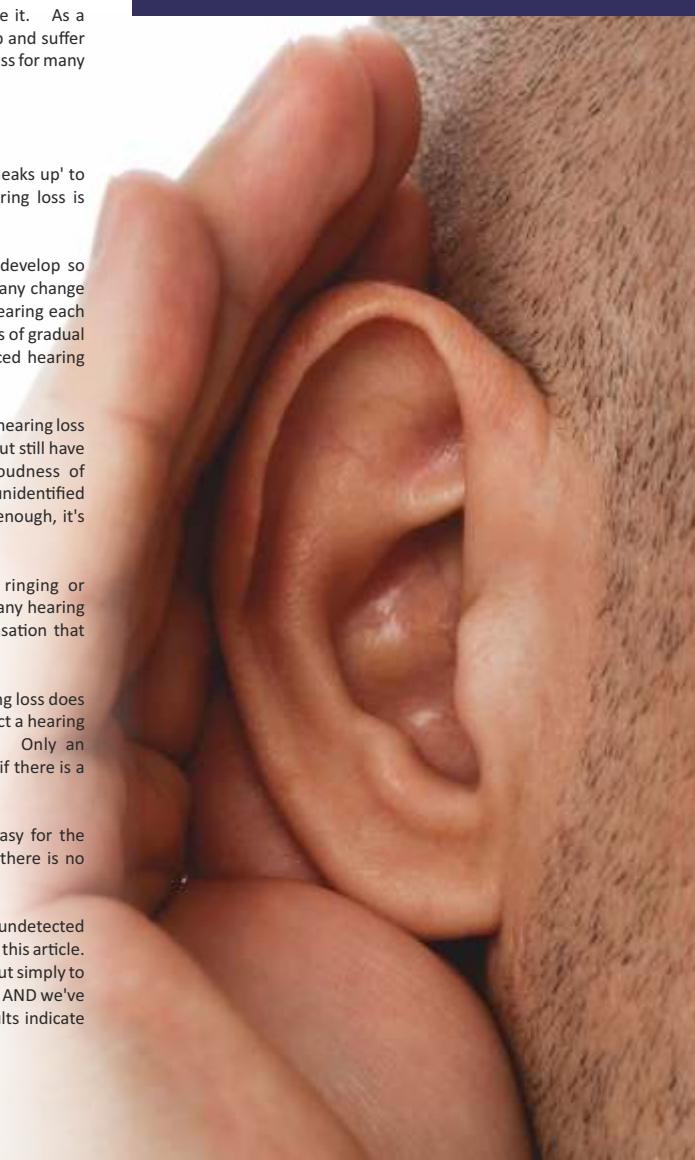
HEARING LOSS CHARACTERISTICS

In most cases hearing loss in adults 'sneaks up' to the individual. That is because hearing loss is usually:

- **GRADUAL** – a loss of hearing can develop so slowly that the person is not aware of any change from year to year. A loss of 1dB of hearing each year is not noticeable but 10 or 20 years of gradual loss can result in a significant, unnoticed hearing problem.
- **PARTIAL** – It is not unusual to have a hearing loss for sounds in the speech clarity range but still have normal hearing for noise and the loudness of speech. That's why someone with an unidentified hearing loss may say "Speech is loud enough, it's just not clear enough".
- **PAINLESS** – Although tinnitus (a ringing or buzzing sound in the ear) may accompany hearing loss, usually there is no feeling or sensation that alerts you to a change in hearing.
- **INVISIBLE** – The person with a hearing loss does not look different and you can not detect a hearing loss by looking in someone's ears. Only an audiological evaluation can determine if there is a hearing loss.

Because of these characteristics it's easy for the person with a hearing loss to believe there is no problem.

If you know someone who may have an undetected hearing loss, please ask him/her to read this article. The first step is not to get hearing aids but simply to have a professional hearing evaluation. AND we've never had anyone complain if the results indicate normal hearing!!



GEHOORVERLIES VERBIND AAN DEMENSIE

Daar is bevind dat Senior burgers met 'n groot gehoorverlies betekenisvol meer geneig is tot die ontwikkeling van demensie in vergelyking met seniors wie se gehoor behoue gebly het of wie gehoorapparate gebruik het.

Die risiko vir Alzheimers het veral verhoog met afname in gehoor. Die studie het bevind dat vir elke afname van 10dB in die gehoor, die risiko met 20% verhoog was.

By persone ouer as 60 jaar was meer as een derde van die risiko om demensie te ontwikkel geassosieer met gehoorverlies. Die tydige opsporing en behandeling van 'n gehoorverlies kan hierdie risiko beduidend verminder.

HEARING LOSS – SPEAKING TO A LOVED ONE



Is someone you know exhibiting symptoms of a hearing loss? Are you concerned that the loss of hearing may be changing their life for the worse?

Because the person with a hearing loss may not notice their hearing loss, loving family members and good friends often have to start the conversation about hearing loss.

HOW TO START THE CONVERSATION

Because hearing loss is an invisible disability that the hearing impaired have absolutely no control over, do not start with statements like "You can't hear me anymore". Rather structure the conversation as follows:

- Ask if they experience any problems hearing
- Talk about how hearing loss can impact their ability to cope.
- Have they changed their activities like not going to meetings / parties / church anymore.

- Use the common signs and symptoms of hearing loss to talk about the person's hearing loss
- Go with them to the hearing test so that you can talk about your perspective as well
- STOP BEING THEIR EARS. Try not to repeat everything for them. This will force them to do something about the problem.

BE CAREFUL OF DIY HEARING CARE

The Better Hearing Institute has issued a warning to consumers on the risks associated with purchasing over-the counter, 'one-size-fits-all' hearing aids instead of consulting a hearing health care professional.

In its warning the BHI noted that hearing loss is sometimes the symptom of a serious underlying medical condition that the audiologist will pick up during your hearing evaluation.

Hearing devices purchased over the counter or Internet without a consultation, may result in devices not accurately customised and may even damage your remaining hearing.

“AGTER-DIE-OOR” GEHOORAPPARATE DOMINEER DIE MARK

Waar die keuse van 'n agter-die-oorgehoorapparaat in 1999 slegs 20,3% van alle gehoorapparaat verkope uitgemaak het, het daar 'n dramatiese skuif plaasgevind in verbruikers voorkeur. In 2012 het die wêreldwye voorkeur van agter-die-oorgehoorapparate 70.8% van verkope uitgemaak.

Hierdie verskuiwing is waarskynlik die gevolg van die beter kwaliteit wat hierdie apparate lewer. Beter klankversterking, beter spraakdiskriminasie, beter gerief en verminderde okklusie (toe gevoel in die oor).

Die amper onsigbare apparate verloor daagliks veld. In 2010 het hulle verkope 8,5% uitgemaak, in 2011 slegs 7,7 en die syfer gaan steeds agteruit. Dit is waarskynlik te wyte aan die kort battery leeftyd en die gebrek aan enige beheer deur die gebruiker. Die nuwe agter-die-oorapparaat is nie net effektief nie maar ook modern en mooi

MYTHS

- When people don't hear well, it probably means they're getting senile
Wrong!!! Hearing loss has a variety of causes, but has nothing to do with senility. However failure to seek help can lead to communication difficulties and social isolation.
- If you shout loud enough, people with a hearing loss will understand you better.
Wrong!! In fact loud conversation may be painful. Loudness will not make the distorted sound any clearer and may make the situation worse.
- Hearing loss is rare.
Wrong. Well over 10% of the population has a hearing loss. Unfortunately many people don't confront the challenge head on. Its not a shame to wear hearing aids. Its a shame not to stay in touch with people around you.
- Hearing loss only affects the elderly.
Wrong. More than half the people with hearing loss are under the age of 65. It can affect people of all ages
- Hearing aids didn't work for someone I know, so they won't work for me
Wrong. Adjustment to amplification is a process which can take months. People who don't expect a restoration of their natural hearing and who are willing to wear their instruments regularly in order to become used to the new sounds, will enjoy the benefits of improved communication. People who try their hearing aids once or twice and then give up do not receive any benefit. As with any endeavor people get out of amplification what they are willing to put into it.
- Hearing aids correct hearing 100%.
Wrong. While new hearing aids can compensate for many losses, they cannot restore normal hearing. They can help you get the most listening enjoyment from the hearing you still have.
- I've heard my type of hearing loss can't be helped
Wrong. In most cases, nerve deafness can be helped through amplification. Now there is hope for those who have been told they couldn't be helped.

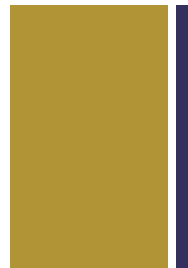

GEHOOR VERBIND MENSE



Ons gehoorsintuig is 'n belangrike deel van ons alledaagse kommunikasie. Ons dink selde aan hierdie belangrike rol wat gehoor in ons lewens speel.

Dit is van uiterste belang om die klank van die deurklokkie, 'n baba wat huil of roep of die lui van die wekker te kan hoor. Maar ons lewe se kwaliteit word egter bepaal deur die meer subtiele klanke: die lag van 'n gelukkige kind, musiek of die drup van die reën op die dak.

Geluide kan ook belangrike inligting verskaf: Die klank van ons voetstappe verskaf ruimtelike oriëntering. Die klank van motors maak ons bewus van moontlike gevare op straat. Baie klanke is egter verbind aan ons herinneringse. Dink aan 'n somersdag met voëlgesang of die herfs met die geritsel van die vallende blare.

Mense met 'n gehoorverlies vind selfs 'n eenvoudige gesprek inspannend. Wanneer daar meer mense teenwoordig is of die gesprek meer aandag vereis dit soveel meer aandag en inspanning.

Baie aspekte van die alledaagse lewe word nou al hoe moeiliker: gesprekke met jou geliefdes, vergaderings, telefoongesprekke en TV kyk kan veral uitputtend wees. Dikwels sal persone met 'n gehoorverlies onttrek omdat kommunikasie te moeilik word en dan sosiaal geïsoleerd word. Hierdie isolasie veroorsaak dan dat hulle kwaliteit van lewe al hoe meer ingeperk word.

Studies het getoon dat mense met 'n gehoorverlies wat nie gehoorapparate gebruik nie meer hartseer, spanning en angs ervaar as diegene wat dit wel gebruik. Hulle sosiale aktiwiteite word beperk, hulle word meer emosioneel en ervaar probleme om te konsentreer.

Aan die ander kant toon studies ook dat die kwaliteit van lewe 'n dramatiese verbetering toon wanneer hulle gehoorapparate begin gebruik. Hulle beleef beter verhoudinge met die familie, het meer selfvertroue en ervaar beter onafhanklikheid end sekuriteit.

“n Gehoorverlies wat nie aangespreek word nie kan resulteer in fisiese probleme soos uitgeputheid, hoofpyn, duiseligheid en stress. Hierdie probleme word nie altyd deur 'n onbehandelde gehoorverlies veroorsaak nie maar dit word dikwels opgemerk.

As jy 'n gehoorverlies het en jy herken party van hierdie simptome behoort jy so gou as moontlik jou gehoor te laat toets.
